RULES

1. Classes are **free** to enter but **Entry Forms** for both Juniors and Adults should be submitted between **Monday 19th and Wednesday 28th August 2018**.
2. **Completed forms** should be left in the **post box on the Village Hall gate** or **sent by e-mail** to show@petercoates.plus.com.
3. Entry is open to anyone who resides, is employed or has a garden in the Parish of Longhirst. **Their children, grandchildren and youngsters who attend the Youth Activities Group are also eligible to compete.**
4. Only one entry per class is allowed and entrants must show their own produce.
5. **Exhibits** can be set up in the Village Hall at the following times
Saturday 31st August between 2pm and 5pm
Sunday 1st September between 9am and 11am
Exhibits should not be removed before 3.15pm
Exhibits will be gratefully received for sale by Auction at 3.45pm

6. SPECIAL RULES

Vegetables Class 1: 3 potatoes, 6 pods peas, 6 pods beans count as one vegetable

Photographs: to be no more than **35 square inches, e.g. 5" x 7"** and shown unmounted, except for the Open Class 81. 'Open photos' are not eligible for the trophy for the Best Exhibit in the Photographic Section.

Cookery: Class 71 will not be eligible for the trophy for the Best Exhibit in the Cookery section.

7. **The judges'** decisions are final.
8. **The committee** reserve the right to inspect gardens in the week before the Show.
9. **Any entrant** contravening any of the rules may be disqualified from all classes.

2. 3 potatoes – (*any shape – any colour*)
3. 3 onions dressed – (*any colour*)
4. 6 pods of peas
5. 6 French beans
6. 6 runner beans
7. 3 carrots
8. 3 globe beetroot
9. 1 cauliflower
10. 1 vegetable marrow
11. 1 summer cabbage
12. 6 shallots - any colour
13. 6 radishes as grown – (*washed*)
14. 3 courgettes
15. 1 head lettuce
16. 1 cucumber

17. 1 pumpkin
18. A pepper plant in pot
19. 6 standard tomatoes (ripe)
20. 6 cherry tomatoes (ripe)
21. Best truss of tomatoes (*ripe or unripe*)
22. A plate of fruit for effect – (*you need not have to have grown the fruit*)
23. Any odd-shaped vegetable
24. A pot of herbs, or single herb in a pot
25. Any 1 flower and 1 vegetable
26. Any other vegetable
27. Four apples
28. Six plums
29. 3 heaviest potatoes - (*washed*)
30. The heaviest onion
31. The heaviest marrow
32. The longest bean

33. Best arrangement from the open border
34. Bowl of hydrangeas
35. 6 blooms sweet peas any colour, no decoration
36. 3 spikes phlox
37. 2 decorative dahlias
